Only digital images on a CD will be accepted. Please follow all specifications carefully.

Eligibility

- **PSA members in good standing:** Membership must be current for the 2009-2010. Annual membership dues are \$50. Membership applications are available by request or online and must be submitted separately.
- **PSA Advisory Board Members** are invited to bring one piece that has not been exhibited in recent PSA events to the exhibit on the delivery date as long as it is within the size specifications and is available for the duration of the exhibit. **Though it will not be sent to the Juror, please submit a photo and a CD with an image of the work by the entry deadline for our permanent records, web site display and to help in planning the space needed.**
- **Non-member artists** subject to committee review.

Work Eligibility

Works exhibited in the last two exhibitions are not eligible. Works previously exhibited in any **TWO** PSA exhibitions will not be accepted. All mediums are permitted. **No nudes, photography, class work, or copies permitted.** Works must also have been created within the past five years. Please see **Accreditation** section. Paintings submitted to any PSA show **MUST** be available for display for the

duration of the show. *No substitutes are allowed.* Please inform your client of the dates for which a borrowed work will be on view. **Failure to provide any works that have been juried into a show will result in disqualification for that artist from entering future PSA exhibitions. NO EARLY REMOVAL IS PERMITTED.**

Jury

Juried by digital image on CD submission only. Entrants may submit up to three images of paintings and/or sculptures. (Three images may be submitted of each sculpture piece to show various views.) To insure that your images are not declined, please follow the **Requirements for Digital Entries** herein. **Please do not submit images of any work that is not available for display.** Only juried work will be exhibited. Any work that varies from the submitted images will be disqualified. This show will be of framed works (or gallery wrap) and sculptures only. **Artwork size requirements (including frame) are NO LARGER than 48" x 40" (Vertical x Horizontal). Sculpture may not exceed 30" in any direction and weight may not exceed 50 pounds.** **Please Note: Under no circumstances may entrants directly contact the Juror. All communication and questions pertaining to PSA Exhibitions must be directed to PSA representatives listed in this prospectus.**

Requirements for Digital Entries

- No frames or extraneous background allowed in the image. Please have image cropped properly.
- One CD must contain all entries from an individual artist, and must be burned properly to enable reading on either PC or Mac computers.
- Images must be JPG (JPEG) format.
- Images must be sized to be 1500 pixels in the largest dimension when viewed at 72 dpi.
- Clearly label CD with artist name and for each image list the file name, title, medium and size of the artwork. Please give the dimensions of the actual canvas image, not the frame.
- CD files must be named as follows: Artist's last name, first 3 letters of artist's first name, brief or abbreviated title, hyphen & image number, .jpg (Example: **Jones,Kev,Jessica-1.jpg** for the first entry image, and for the next entry: **Jones,Kev,SenMitchell-2.jpg**, etc.)

- A **LABELED** color print out (no larger than 5"x7") of each digital file image must accompany the CD to accurately reflect the images on the CD.
- CDs and photos become the property of the PSA and will not be returned. However, a SASE with at least \$1.50 postage will be required for notification and to receive invitations for finalists to mail out.
- CDs must be packed in paper sleeves with cardboard for protection, or a cardboard CD mailer. Do not send hard plastic CD cases.

Framing

All accepted work must be properly framed (or gallery wrapped accepted), wired and labeled and have a suitable backing-paper, cardboard, foam board, etc. No saw-tooth hangers, or gallery clips accepted. Juried work will not be hung if it does not meet these guidelines. On the back of each painting, attach a 3x5 card to the top right hand corner with your name, title, medium and phone number, or card must also accompany sculpture.

Delivery and Display

Accepted work must be delivered to The Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 14, 2010.

Artists must make arrangements for delivery and return of shipped artwork directly with the Museum. Shipped deliveries also must include labeling stating "For PSA Exhibition". Shipped works need to include return postage pre-paid or accompanied with proper payment for return deliveries. Please do NOT use foam pebbles for packing materials.

Removal of Work

Work is to be removed on Tuesday, Dec. 21, 2010, between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. **Without exceptions, artists are to be responsible for making delivery and pick-up arrangements for their own work if personally unavailable to do so.**

PSA Accreditation

Only members' works **not** previously juried into a PSA exhibit will receive accreditation points toward membership status. **Only Juried Members and higher are permitted to display business cards and information during the show if space permits.**

Insurance

Insurance is the sole responsibility of the artist. Though great care will be taken when handling your work, the PSA and The Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art, its staff and director will not be held responsible for loss or damage to works. There is an excellent security system in the facility. This is acknowledged by signing the entry form.

Sales

The Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art will take a 20% commission on any sale occurring as a result of this exhibition while on display. Works that are not-for-sale (NFS) also are permitted.

Rights

PSA and The Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art reserve the right to photograph and retain images of the exhibit. These materials will be used solely for educational, promotional, and documentation purposes in print or on the internet.

Entry Fee

Entries that DO NOT adhere to this prospectus or are not complete will not be submitted to the juror and will be returned to the entrant.

Members: \$35 for up to three images.

Non-members: \$55 for up to three images

• **Submit CD, labeled color prints, completed jury form, entry fee, and self-addressed STAMPED envelope.** Please make sure you use at least \$1.50 postage on your return envelope. **Please DO NOT send via Fed-Ex, UPS, or overnight mail where a signature is required for delivery.**

Burt Silverman has exhibited in galleries and museums since 1956. He has had 31 solo shows in New York, Boston, Philadelphia, Washington D.C., and shown in numerous group international venues such as the Mexico City Museum of Art and the Royal Academy of Art in London. He has won 33 prizes, including awards from many of these exhibitions, and in 2002 he received an honorary doctorate from the Academy of Art University in San Francisco. His paintings are represented in more than two dozen public collections, including the Brooklyn Museum of Art, the Philadelphia Museum of Art, the Denver Art Museum, the Smithsonian American Art Museum, the Delaware Art Museum, the Columbus Museum and the National Portrait Gallery.
